Fight every crisis –Global perspectives of a Post-Corona-Economy

Society is confronted with multiple crises: Poverty, the climate crisis and the corona pandemic interact and exacerbate each other. At the same time, there is now a worldwide opportunity to overcome economic crises with new creativity and imagination. The coronavirus crisis has brought to light numerous practices of solidarity in finding new forms of social interaction in different contexts in order to deal with instability. These practices can give rise to new narratives for a capacity for action in the face of global crises.

In our digital lecture series, global phenomena are to be considered from multiple perspectives. Innovative narratives and creative forms of actions are to be discovered and researched which question and fundamentally change the old narratives that underlie conventional economic activity. In particular, speakers from the Global South will have their say. The *Cusanus Hochschule für Gesellschaftsgestaltung* thus makes an academic contribution to the development of a post-corona economy.
